

## Web-based Resources Required Elements and Definitions

1. **Title:** identifies the topic; descriptive heading using appropriate capitalization.
2. **Subject/Course:** a course or area of study composed of units or course of study.
3. **Grade Level:** a level of student academic development.
4. **Standards/Eligible Content:** shows the connection between the resource and the standard, anchor, anchor descriptor, and/or eligible content.
  - PA Academic Standards
  - PA Core Standards
5. **Description:** an overview or general summary providing the user with the purpose, objective, or focus of the resource.
6. **Rationale:** a detailed explanation of the relevance of the resource for learning and instruction; this may also include suggestions for teachers to use the resource in the classroom.
7. **URL or Resource:** Identifies the URL or the resource with any necessary directions for accessing the resource.
8. **Content Provider or Additional Information:** If the content is being provided by a content provider through a partnership, this area would include information about that particular content provider or organization.
9. **Keywords:** words or phrases that are entered for tagging/search purposes – these will NOT be displayed to the end user.
